

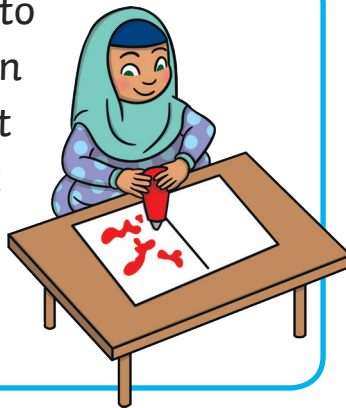
Using Phonics Skills for Writing

Home Learning Challenges



Use your phonic skills to help your grown-up write a shopping list.

Use your phonics skills to make a poster to display in your bedroom window. It could show who you want to say thank you to or it could be a special message you would like to share.



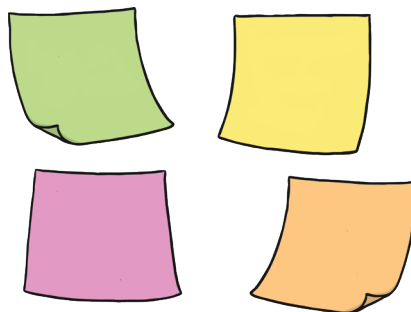
Spread out big pieces of paper with letters written on them on the floor. Your grown-up can say a simple word and you can jump on and say the letters that make that word.



Spread a layer of sand, flour or uncooked rice into the base of a tray. Ask a grown-up to say a word, then use your finger or a paintbrush to write the word into the sand. Try writing these words: sun, box, tap, coat, moon.



Write some letters on small pieces of paper or sticky notes. Can you build words with the letters?



Make a collection of objects from around your house. Can you write labels for each object on small pieces of paper?
